

PISTOL & RIFLE RANGE RULES

ACCESS:

1. This is a **MEMBERS ONLY** range. When on the range your badge/card must be displayed and visible to others at all times.
2. Keep range gate closed and locked at all times. Lock the gate behind you when you enter/exit.
3. Range Hours – shooting is permitted from 8:00 a.m. until dusk.

USE:

1. Keep area clean. Remove targets when done shooting and dispose of spent casings.
2. Targets -
 - No cans / bottles or items that were not manufactured for the purpose of being a target.
 - No exploding targets
 - Rifle Range – No Steel Plates/Targets may be shot at a distance closer than 50 yards. Must use all lead bullets or frangible bullets only.
 - Pistol Range – No Steel Plates/Targets may be shot at a distance closer than 25 yards.
 - Please be respectful of other shooters on the range.
3. Shoot only at targets on the target (homasote) boards or safely placed in front of an existing backstop. Please do not shoot the target board posts or cross-members.
4. Do not shoot targets on the silhouette (metal) rails with any center-fire rifle or handgun.
5. No shooting at wildlife.
6. Dogs must be leashed at all times.
7. Children must be supervised at all times.
8. Use of the 'RANGE OPEN' & 'STOP NO SHOOTING' sign is mandatory. The sign pivots easily and locks into place by use of a pin. Rotate the sign when going down range and when the range is going hot.
9. Coordinate all downrange movement with all other shooters, including (especially) between the rifle and pistol portions of the range.
10. Do NOT shoot from a position other than an established shooting point without the agreement of ALL other shooters on the range.
11. There is ONE firing line – shooters at the 12 & 25 yard range need to fire from the cement area.
12. No intoxicating beverages or controlled substances on range. No intoxicated persons at the range.

WEAPONS / AMMUNITION:

1. No fully automatic weapons or extreme rapid fire.
2. No .50 BMG.
3. No armor piercing ammunition.
4. No tracer or incendiary ammunition.
5. Shotgun slugs or sabots only. No patterning of shotguns (birdshot/buckshot) on the range at any time. Please use the shotgun patterning frame alongside the airgun range by the main clubhouse.

RISK:

1. Individuals using the range do so at their own risk and assume all responsibility. for injuries to persons and property done to or by them.
2. Eye and ear protection is mandatory when using firearms on club grounds.

Persons violating any of these rules will be subjected to loss of membership, as prescribed by the Board of Directors.
